6	6.1	Report from the Clerk on actions requested in the minutes  May 3 <sup>rd</sup> minutes-Item 8.1-The Clerk has received the following response from Chris Gardiner-Amey:  With reference to your enquiry regarding Public Footpath UB22 Upton Bishop;  The path has not been moved or diverted. I had a site visit with the landowner a few weeks ago and with a GPS plotter we marked out the correct legal line of the path. This was in conjunction with the ongoing planning application/enquiry so that all parties were aware of the correct legal line.  The result was that it was discovered that the wire fence which ran alongside the path at the northerly end towards Tanhouse Lane was obstructing the path very minimally at a couple of points. The landowner agreed to move the fence and has since done so and the path remains unobstructed along its length to the satisfaction of this department. The route has now been adequately waymarked through Marsh Farm.  I think there was a misconception that the path followed a straighter line across the field, however the way marking and moving of the fence should see the public using the route in the correct location.
