Mr Brian Griffin (agent for Ms Rigby) put forward details of new government guidelines on planning along with details of Ms Rigby's personal circumstances. It was highlighted that this was a personal application for Ms Rigby and that, if approved, would only be for the remainder of her life. Mrs Jackie Ivemy spoke on behalf of those people who had signed a petition in support of the Planning Application. A period of Q&A then followed where not only was further support expressed by members of the public present but also concerns were expressed by members of the PC with regard to the history of the application and the dangers of setting a precedent. A vote then took place with 3 Cllrs in support and 4 Cllrs against. The Parish Council objects to this application
