### Economy and Employment

The economy of Upton Bishop Parish has varied range of industry including the manufacture and installation of industrial machinery, manufacture of metal products and a variety of agricultural related businesses. Specifically in the Parish we have Chicory Crops, Muddy Boots, Windy Hollow, Move It, Blue Sky Essential Oil Company, and Red House Nursery. A new egg unit has recently been built which employs a number of people and there are also numerous small scale 'cottage industries'. It is assumed that a significant number of people work from home.
