Community Services and Facilities

- Upton Bishop Parish has no school
- The Parish Church is located away from the main centres of population making access difficult
- The Millennium Hall is a busy village hall, located between Crow Hill and Upton Crews
- The church uses the Hall for many events and there are also a large selection of special interest clubs and groups including, village hall committees, keep fit, WI, quilters, badminton, tea dance, etc.
- It is also used by groups from outside the parish and also hosts weddings, birthday parties and other events
- The Hall has a large open space that provides a play area for local children in addition to the areas at Pomona Grove and Spring Meadow
- The Parish has no shop or post office. Parishioners have to use the new community shop/Post Office in Gorsley, or go into Ross or Newent. Given the lack of a regular bus service this generates more car journeys
- The parish has one public house, The Moody Cow - open only part of the week. It is more of a restaurant than a local public house
- There are two golf courses nearby just outside the Parish
- Coarse Fishing is available at Phocle Green and also at Drummonds Drub just outside of the Parish
- There are several equestrian centres offering riding tuition
