## Great Domesday Book Entry - Translation

### Translation of Great Domesday Book Folio 182r

---

#### HEREFORDSHIRE

with 4 ploughs, and 3 slaves. The reeve of the vill has 1 mill rendering 32d. TRE and afterwards, as now, worth 10l15s

#### IN BROMSASH HUNDRED

In '**WHIPPINGTON**' [in Staunton, [Glos.] are 3 hides which by rights belong to the bishopric. They are waste and were waste. There is a fishery.

In **WALFORD** are 7 hides paying geld. In demesne is 1 plough, and there could be 2 more. There are 6 villans and 4 bordars with 5 ploughs. There are 14 acres of meadow and 3 enclosures. The villans pay 10s for the waste land.

In **ROSS-ON-WYE** are 7 hides paying geld. In demesne is 1 plough, and there could be another. There are 18 villans and 6 bordars and a priest with 23 ploughs. There are 3 slaves, and a mill rendering 6s8d , and 16 acres of meadow. The woodland is in the king's preserve. The villans pay 18s as revenue.

In **UPTON BISHOP** are 7 hides paying geld. In demesne are 2 ploughs; and 18 villans and 11 bordars and 2 boors and a priest. Among them all they have 28 ½ ploughs. There are 5 slaves, and 4 acres of meadow and an enclosure, and woodland rendering nothing. The villans pay 20s as a customary due. These 3 manors, Walford, and Ross-on-Wye, and Upton Bishop, are valued at 14l.

#### IN "WIMUNDESTREU" HUNDRED

In **LEDBURY** are 5 hides. In demesne are 2 ploughs; and 10 villans and 1 boor with 11 ploughs. There is a mill rendering 32d , and 7 acres of meadow. [There is] woodland half a league long and a half broad, and it renders nothing. Of this manor a priest holds 2 ½ hides, and 2 knights 1 hide, and a radman 3 virgates. These have in demesne 10 ploughs; and 7 bordars with other men having 8 ploughs, and [there is] part of a salt-pan in Droitwich [Worcs.]. TRE it was worth 10l ; and afterwards, as now, 8l. What the priest holds is worth 50s.

Of this manor Earl Harold held 1 hide, **HAZLE** unjustly, and Godric [held] of him. King William restored it to Bishop Walter.

- In demesne are 3 ploughs; and 4 villans with 3 ploughs, and a mill rendering 2s , and 7 acres of meadow. TRE and afterwards, as now, worth 25s.

In **EASTNOR** are 4 hides paying geld. In demesne are 3 ploughs; and 8 villans and 7 bordars with 11
