1.1	Open Discussion for Local Residents to Raise Local Issues A number of parishioners were in attendance to discuss the speed limits in the parish, and the want for the B4224 to be reduced from 40mph to 30mph. It was also requested to move the speed limit further out on the B4221. It was confirmed that a representative had been out following discussions with Herefordshire Council and a seven day traffic monitor would be put in place to quantify the number of vehicles using the B4224. Cllr Durkin confirmed that only the police have authority to change speed limits. He also confirmed that parishioners could use a speed measuring device in the village to gauge the average speed of the traffic with advise from The Safer Roads Partnership. Cllr Durkin also confirmed that following the accident in the village earlier in the year, an extension to the speed limit was being considered and he was waiting to hear the outcome
