He also confirmed once again that the RSPCA were happy with the conditions the dogs are kept in. And also suggested everyone effected by the noise pollution, keep a record for Environmetal Health. One parishioner who had already been in touch with Environmental Health reported that they were very dismissive of the matter. It was suggested to put a note on the website for all parishioners effected to contact the council
